Helpful tips when buying a vehicle:

- ✓ Get Pre-approved at the CU! You DO NOT have to finance with the dealer
- ✓ Negotiate one price- The selling price of the vehicle
- ✓ NEVER negotiate based on monthly payments, always negotiate everything separately (i.e Extended Warranties packaging deals)
- ✓ Discuss the trade-in after you have negotiated the best price possible for your new car (research the value of your current vehicle @ NADA before shopping)
- ✓ Monthly payments should be no more than 15% of your take-home pay
- ✓ Limit car loans to 48 months or less
- ✓ Down payment should be at least 20% of the purchase price

SCAMS TO BE AWARE OF:

1. **Grandparents-** scammers will call and pretend to be your grandchild. They will ask if you know who it is and once you say a name they will request for money and tell you not to tell their parents.
2. **Puppy-** a scammer will post a picture of a puppy that needs rehomed ASAP and will make you put a "deposit" on this puppy, and in the end there really is no puppy to be sold.
3. **Email-** a scammer will send an email to you telling you, you need to "update" or "verify" your personal information on a website that doesn't usually send emails.
4. **Sweepstake & lottery-** scammers will call and say you have won a free trip to a beautiful destination, but you have to send a certain amount for the "taxes & fees"
